Through core initiatives – the Miller Business Center, 211 Long Island Database, and Family Place Libraries™ – the MCL Foundation continues to do all it can to support and nurture the families, individuals, and businesses that make our community strong.

The Miller Business Center continues to provide skill-building programs and resources for job seekers and entrepreneurs. With many networking opportunities, job fairs, and the increasingly popular Business Networking Open House, there are always opportunities to create relationships and forge strong connections with local and regional businesses. Strictly Business and Women's EXPO continue to grow in popularity, welcoming more than 3,000 people in combined attendance. Additionally, the Center provided over 50 workshops, 260 career counseling appointments, and a variety of literacy programming designed to generate a stronger, business-ready workforce.


As the region's most comprehensive information and referral resource, **211 Long Island** Database connected over 400,000 unique visitors to the health and human services they needed and supported the 211 Long Island call center, which helped an average of 350 callers each month. By providing information and referrals to those in need of food, rent payment assistance, utility payment assistance, job training, and much more, 211 Long Island Database acted as a lifeline to thousands of Long Islanders in need of the basic necessities of daily life.

Family Place Libraries™ continues to be a transformative and highly effective model for early childhood and family support services. Family Place expanded to over 500 libraries in 33 states. National and regional professional development opportunities were offered to over 350 librarians in 20 states through webinars, workshops, and the Foundation's Distinguished Speakers Series.
